SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 319, L.D. 949, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow Unions to Negotiate on Behalf of Former Employees of a Company with Which the Union is Negotiating."

Amend the bill by striking out everthing after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'§9. Negotiations on behalf of retired employees

Employee organizations, unions and bargaining agents in the private sector engaged in collective bargaining with employers may negotiate on behalf of retired and retired disabled former employees of the employer with respect to pensions, retirement benefits and other benefits which, as a part of wages and benefits related to employment, are, were or may be carried with retired employees into retirement.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the application to the private sector and to include retired disabled as well as retired former employees.
