IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Extend the Maine Jobs Tax Credit Law for 3 Years.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § **5213, sub-**§ **3**, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 686, § 15, is amended to read:

3. Repeal. This section shall be repealed on January 1, 1980 1983.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to extend by 3 years the date for repeal of the new jobs credit under the Maine Income Tax.
