"AN ACT to Establish a Special License for Retired or Inactive

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2903-A."

in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) by inserting after the years of age underlined figure "\$10" the following: 'if he is 65/or older,

or \$30 if he is under 65,'

Statement of Fact

This amendment fixes the nonactive license renewal fee at years \$10 for pharmacists who are 65/or older and \$30 for pharmacists who are under 65.
