COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 766, L.D. 971, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for the Registration and Regulation of Off-road Vehicles."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2022.", first paragraph, by striking out in the 10th line (8th line in L.D.) the underlined amount "§4.75" and inserting in its place the following: '\$5.25'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§2022.", first paragraph, by striking out in the 11th and 12th lines (9th and 10th in L.D.) the following underlined words and figure: "50¢ of each fee shall be credited to the Bureau of Parks and Recreation"

Further amend the Bill in that / designated "§2022." by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'All moneys credited to the department, including registration fees, shall be expended by the department solely for the cost of administration, establishment of a safety program for off-road vehicle operators and enforcement of this chapter.'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§2026." by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Any person who is in the business of selling off-road vehicles in the State shall register as a dealer and secure a dealer's license from the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Off-road vehicles so registered do not need to be individually registered. Dealers shall display their dealer's number on each such off-road vehicle being so used. Upon the sale of the off-road vehicle, it is then the owner's responsibility to register the off-road vehicle.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment corrects several errors in the bill. It also provides that the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will administer off-road vehicle registrations.
