AN ACT to Appropriate \$30,000 to Day One, Inc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation; Day One, Inc. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

	1979-80
DAY ONE, INC.	\$30,000

To be used to maintain an office and staff needed to serve York and Cumberland counties by providing public, nonprofit residential drug treatment centers.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill appropriates \$30,000 to Day One, Inc., of Cumberland and York counties. These funds shall be used to maintain an office and necessary staff.

Day One, Inc., is the only public, nonprofit residential drug treatment center in the State.
