SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 784, L.D. 984, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Certain Maine Pharmacists to Fill the Prescription of Certain Nonresident Physicians."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, there is an urgent need along the borders of this State for authority to fill nonresident prescriptions; and

Whereas, legislation is necessary to allow people in these communities who use services of nonresident physicians to continue to obtain proper medications; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine<sup>and</sup> require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
