HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 798,
L.D. 992, Bill, "AN ACT for Expression of Public Sentiment on
the Dickey-Lincoln Hydroelectric Power Project by Referendum."

Amend the amendment by striking out on page 2, all of the
first 5 lines and inserting in their place the
following:

"What combination of / additional energy resources do you / favor being
developed up to
in Maine? Please select / 4 of the alternatives listed below.

1. The Dickey-Lincoln hydroelectric facility on the St.
in River;
2. An additional nuclear generating facility;
3. A coal-fired steam generating facility;
4. A large-scale tidal power project;
5. A system of small-scale tidal power projects;
6. Development of low-head hydroelectric facilities on
Maine rivers;
7. Alternative pumped-storage hydroelectric facilities;
8. Alternative wood-fire steam generating facilities;
9. Development of solar systems; or
10. Development of wind systems?"
