HOUSE AMENDMENT"<sup>A</sup>to H.P. 798, L.D. 992, Bill, "AN ACT for Expression of Public Sentiment on the Dickey-Lincoln Hydroelectric Power Project by Referendum."

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the first sentence and inserting in its place the following:  
'The Secretary of State shall, at the statewide election on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November 1980, hold a special advisory referendum to determine the sentiment of the people on whether or not the Dickey-Lincoln hydroelectric power project should be constructed.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out in the first sentence the following: "following passage of this Act" and inserting in its place the following: ' 1980'
