COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 338, L.D. 999, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Clarify the Liability of Employers Under the

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the  
period, the following:

'provided the exemption shall not apply in any case where  
the injury or death is prominently caused by the willful  
and unprovoked physical aggression of the employee, officer  
or director'

to the immunity of employees, officers or directors of the  
employer.
