COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 809, L.D. 1012, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify Habitual Offender Penalties."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'29 MRSA §2298, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 10,
§2, is amended by adding at the end the following new
sentence:

The imposition or execution of any sentence imposed under this
section shall not be suspended and probation shall not be granted.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment corrects the bill to account for the
reenactment of the habitual offender law earlier this session.
