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**AN ACT to Clarify Habitual Offender Penalties.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**29 MRSA § 2280**, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 410, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

**The imposition or execution of any sentence imposed under this section shall not be suspended and probation shall not be granted.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to amend the law dealing with the habitual offender law under the motor vehicle statutes. This bill would provide that any sentence imposed upon a person as a habitual offender may not be suspended and probation may not be granted.
