**AN ACT Relating to the State Apprenticeship Council.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**26 MRSA § 1002, first ¶, 5th sentence**, as amended by PL 1975, c. 59, § 3, is further amended to read:

The Director of Vocational Education, the Director of the Bureau of Labor and the ~~Chairman of the Maine Employment Security Commission~~ **Commissioner of Manpower Affairs** shall be ex officio members of the council without vote.

STATEMENT OF FACT

At the time the law was enacted, the positions of Chairman of the Maine Employment Security Commission and the Commissioner of Manpower Affairs were one and the same. As a result of legislation enacted in the 108th Legislature, these 2 positions have become separated as to function and are now completely individual posts.
