HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 858,
L.D. 1058, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Issuance of a
Warning for Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle within One
Month of the Expiration of Registration."

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after
the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'29 MRSA §106, 3rd ¶ from the end, last sentence, as
enacted by PL 1977, c. 481, §5, is amended to read:
However Except as herein provided, when application for re-
registration of an automobile is made after the regis-
tration for the previous year has been expired for -2-months
or more than 30 days, the expiration date of the renewal shall
be at the end of the month, one year from the month of issuance
of the previous registration. If the applicant provides
satisfactory evidence and certifies in writing to the Secretary
of State that the vehicle has not been operated on a public way
during the period of expired registration, the registration
expiration date, upon renewal, is at the end of the month one
year from the month of issuance of the registration renewal.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to resolve a conflict
between one section of the law and the section of the law amended
by the committee amendment. This amendment has the same pro-
visions of the committee amendment but corrects the reference to
the law.
