### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Permitting Businesses to Remain Open 4 Sundays Prior to December 25th.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

17 MRSA § 3204, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 284, § 3, is further amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph a new paragraph to read:

This section shall not apply to the 4 Sundays prior to Christmas Day in any calandar year.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit businesses to remain open on the 4 Sundays preceding Christmas Day.
