COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 874, L.D. 1064, Bill, "AN ACT to Encourage Free and Open Competition in Insurance Funded Repairs."

Amend the bill in the 4th line after the enacting clause (3rd and 4th lines in the L.D.), by striking out the underlined words and/ punctuation
"suggest or recommend" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'or require'

Statement of Fact

This amendment simply prohibits insurers from requiring that insureds have repairs done at a specific place of business. It still permits insurers to suggest or recommend a repair shop.
