HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 874, L.D. 1064, Bill, "AN ACT
to Encourage Free and Open Competition in Insurance Funded Repairs."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the last paragraph and
inserting in its place the following:

'No insurer, domestic or foreign, or its agent or employee,
shall request or require, directly or indirectly, that appraisals
or repairs to motor vehicle glass should or should not be made
in a specified place of business.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment simply prohibits insurers from requiring that
insureds have repairs done at a specific place of business. It
still permits insurers to suggest or recommend a repair shop.
Also, this amendment limits the application of the bill to motor
vehicle glass.
