SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 841, L.D. 1069, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Resident State Police Troopers."

Amend the Bill in section 1, subsection 4, by striking out all of the last sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'For the purposes of this section, employment of a full-time law enforcement officer means . . . payment of wages or a salary of \$4,000 or more during any period of 12 consecutive months subsequent to July 1, 1976, for the services of a local law enforcement officer or officers, as defined in section 2805, subsection 2.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1, subsection 8, paragraph D, by striking out the underlined figure "6" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '7'
