STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Direct the Office of Energy Resources to Promote Energy Conservation Through the Media and Public Demonstrations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 5005, sub-§ 1, ¶ 0, is enacted to read:

0. Prepare and collect advertising material promoting energy conservation and disseminate the material through announcements on television and radio and in the print media, through schools, libraries and other channels. The Office of Energy Resources shall conduct public demonstrations of available energy conservation and production techniques and equipment which have the potential to solve energy problems in Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to direct the Office of Energy Resources to promote energy conservation through the news media and other channels, and to direct the office to conduct public demonstrations of energy conservation and production techniques and equipment which can help solve Maine's energy problems.
