HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 892,  
L.D. 1080, Bill, "AN ACT to Monitor the Juvenile Code."

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 2nd paragraph  
the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 4.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out paragraphs 3, 4  
and 5.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to strike out repealers  
that control jurisdiction of the Criminal Code Revision Commission  
to review the Juvenile Code.

As the Juvenile Code Revision Commission established by this  
Act is intended to monitor implementation, the Criminal Code  
Revision Commission should continue to review the statute itself.  
These 2 bodies will cooperate and will probably share staff.
