HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 348,  
L.D. 1094, Bill, "AN ACT to Regulate Commercial Whitewater  
Outfitters."

Amend the amendment in section 4, in that part designated  
"§2085." subsection 4, in the first sentence, by inserting  
after the underlined word "utilize" the following: 'inflatable  
rubber'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in that part  
designated "§2086." subsection 1 by striking out the following:  
",dory or bateau"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove provisions  
permitting the use of dories and bateaux for commercial  
whitewater trips on rapidly flowing rivers. This would limit the  
type of commercial activity to rubber rafts which are generally  
recognized as being reasonably safe.
