SENATE AMENDMENT " C " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
S. P. 348, L.D. 1094, Bill, "AN ACT to Regulate Commercial
Whitewater Outfitters."


Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the emergency
preamble and all of the emergency clause.

Further amend the Amendment, on page 4, by striking
out all of subsection 1 of that part designated "§2086."
and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Application. Any person in the business of conducting
whitewater rafting or bateau trips on rapidly flowing rivers
shall obtain a license from the commissioner. As used in this
section bateau means a traditional bateau having a minimum of
28 feet from stern-stem to bow-stem.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the emergency
preamble and clause from the amendment, to remove dories
from the licensing provision and^{to} define a bateau in the
traditional sense.
