AN ACT to Partially Exempt Musicians from Coverage for Unemployment Insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

26 MRSA § 1043, sub-§ 11, ¶ F, sub-¶ 33, is enacted to read:

(33) **Services performed by a singer or musician for a nonprofit employer.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exempt singers and musicians from unemployment insurance coverage if their employer is a nonprofit employer.
