STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Requiring Medicaid Recipients to Aid in the Payment of Medical Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 3173, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 674, § 20; c. 696, § 370; c. 712, Part F, § 2, and repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 714, § 2, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

The department shall, in a manner consistent with the requirements for the receipt of federal matching funds under the United States Social Security Act, Title XIX, or its successors, establish a copayment or deductible charge for recipients of assistance under this chapter for medical services rendered in a hospital emergency room or during an office visit.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require recipients of medical assistance to pay a small deductible charge for emergency room and office visits. This charge will help reduce the cost to the State of the medical assistance program.
