**AN ACT to Eliminate Inspection and Registration for Motor Vehicles Used Solely
on Islands.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA § 242, sub-§ 1, ¶ A, first ¶, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1965, c. 304, is amended to read:

Motor vehicles, used for the conveyance of passengers, which are operated exclusively on islands having no roads maintained or supported by the State shall be registered for a fee of \$2 exempted from this section.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA § 2122, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 268, § 1, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Motor vehicles used for the conveyance of passengers which are operated exclusively on islands having no roads maintained or supported by the State shall be exempt from this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill eliminates the inspection and registration requirements for automobiles operated exclusively on islands.
