COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 906, L.D. 1131, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$16,500,000 to Assist Municipalities with Solid Waste Management."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$15,800,000 to Assist Municipalities with Solid Waste Management.'

Further amend the Bill in section 6 in that part designated "<u>§1310.</u>" by striking out all of the 2nd underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following: '<u>The Board of Environmental</u> <u>Protection is authorized to pay an amount not in excess of the</u> <u>amount determined by the formula: Grant = \$2,000 per municipality,</u> <u>except unorganized areas, plus 43¢ per capita or 50% of the total</u> <u>expenses incurred, whichever is less, for expenses incurred by</u> <u>municipal or quasi-municipal entities or their agents in design</u> <u>and engineering for the implementation of solid waste management</u> <u>systems approved by the Board of Environmental Protection.'</u>

Further amend the Bill in section 6 by striking out all of that part designated "<u>§1312.</u>" and inserting in its place the following:

§1312. Retroactive grant awards

The Board of Environmental Protection may pay an amount section authorized by section 1310 or/1311 for expenses incurred subsequent to January 1, 1975, by municipal or quasi-municipal entities for any project that would otherwise qualify for a grant except for the fact that the project began prior to the effective date of this Act.' Further amend the Bill in section 7 in subsection 1 in the 6th line (4th line in L.D.) by striking out the figure "\$16,500,000" and inserting in its place the figure '\$15,800,000'

Further amend the Bill in section 7 in subsection 8 by striking out all of the question and inserting in its place the following:

'Shall a bond issue be ratified in the amount of \$15,800,000 to assist municipalities with solid waste management?'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the ratio of funding design costs to 50% \$tate, 50% local funding. The cutoff date for retroactive awards is changed to January, 1975,50 that the 8 towns that have established complying facilities prior to 1976 would be eligible for grants.
