HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 937,
L.D. 1147, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Method of Appointment to
the Advisory Committee on Medical Education."

Amend the amendment in section 1, subsection 3, paragraph C,
by striking out all of the first underlined sentence and inserting
in its place the following:

'At least 5 positions on the committee shall be assigned
to members of the general public in Maine.'

Further amend the amendment in section 1, subsection 3, by
striking out all of the underlined paragraph D and inserting in
its place the following:

'D. Members shall be appointed for 2-year terms, except
that 7 members, first appointed, who are not designated as
public members shall be appointed for one year.'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are:

1. To clarify that the terms are for 2 years; and
2. To permit more than 5 members to be designated as public
members at the discretion of the commissioner
