# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

### AN ACT Relating to the Plumbing and Subsurface Disposal Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 42, sub-§ 3-A, as amended by PL 1977, c. 694, § 332, is further amended by inserting at the end the following new paragraph:

The department may charge applicants no more than \$60 for examination to become a licensed soil evaluator. The department shall charge a biannual soil evaluator license fee of \$40. Appropriate rules shall be adopted by the department defining the appropriate financial procedure. The fees shall be paid to the Treasurer of State to be maintained as a permanent fund and used by the department for carrying out its plumbing rules and soil evaluation program.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The fee charged applicants for examination to become a licensed soil evaluator and the fee charged for a biannual soil evaluator license will partially recover costs incurred in administering soil evaluation examinations, issuance of licenses and administration of soil evaluation program.
