COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 377, L.D. 1157, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Provision of Services of Developmentally Disabled Children."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill in subsection 4, by striking out all of the underlined 6th paragraph and inserting in its place a new underlined paragraph to read as follows:

'Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, no individual or family required to contribute to the cost of services provided pursuant to this subsection shall pay a weekly fee greater than 10% of their annual adjusted gross income divided by 52.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

1. Clarify the maximum fee that may be charged for the services provided under the bill; and
2. Appropriate the funds needed to supplement the fees charged for services to some families.
