HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 982, L.D. 1162, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow Municipalities

Amend the Amendment by striking out in the 5th line
the underlined word "certain" and inserting the underlined
word 'any'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting after the underlined
word and comma "property," in the 6th line the following:
'except houses of religious worship,'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of
the 11th and 12th lines and inserting in their place
the following:

'A municipality may elect to levy a service charge for one
or more of the following services:'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out everything
after the first 2 sentences on page 2.

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of the
first 9 lines on page 3 and inserting in their place the
following:

'If a municipality levies service charges in any classification
of property, that municipality'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of
the 15th line on page 3 and inserting in its place the
following:

'located within the municipi-'
