SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 935,
L.D. 1165, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Access, Copying and Release
of Medical Records."

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§1712.", sub-
section 2, paragraph A, by striking out all of the 2nd sentence
and inserting in its place the following:

'The reasonable period of time shall mean, for a patient currently
residing in the institution, that the patient shall be permitted
access to records within a period of time not exceeding 24 hours.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to revise the standard
for providing access within a reasonable period of time for
patients residing in the institution.
