HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 960, L.D. 1185, Bill, "AN ACT to Exempt Farmland from Sewer Assessments When the Land Receives no Benefit from this Construction."

Amend the Amendment in that part designated "§4451." by striking out in the 15th line the following: "constructed after August 13, 1947" and inserting in its place the following: "in operation after May 31, 1979."

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the law and to apply the law to sewers and sewerage disposal systems in operation after June 1, 1979. Owners of Farmland, assessed for the construction of sewers and sewerage disposal systems as far back as 1947, will not be eligible for rebates.
