COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " | to H.P. 957, L.D. 1187, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Authority Granted to Municipalities to Enact Police Power Ordinances."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT Relating to the Enactment of Ordinances Concerning Wharves, Piers and Pilings in Portland.'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Ordinances concerning wharves, piers and pilings in Portland.

The municipality of Portland, in exercising its police powers under the Maine Revised Statutes Title 30, section 2151, subsection 4 may enact ordinances concerning wharves, piers and pilings.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to narrow the effect of the bill to only the municipality of Portland.
