IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend the Authority Granted to Municipalities to Enact Police Power Ordinances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2151, sub-§ 4, ¶ C, sub-¶ (1) is amended to read:

(1) The provisions pertaining to buildings apply equally to all structures **including wharves, piers and pilings** and parts of them.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit municipalities to regulate wharves, piers and pilings lying within their jurisdiction in the same way they may now regulate buildings and structures.
