COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 381, L.D. 1213, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Insurance Consultants."

Amend the bill in that part designated "\$1803." by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'1. No person may act as a general lines consultant or a life consultant in this State without first obtaining a license therefor from the superintendent in accordance with this subchapter.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of that part designated "\$1811."

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the reference to "central licensing". In addition, the Administrative Procedure Act is utilized relative to suspension or revocation of licenses. Title 24-A, sections 1539 through 1542 adequately provide for suspension or revocation of licenses issued pursuant to Title 24-A, chapter 17, thus also covering subchapter IV, the Insurance Consultant Law.
