**AN ACT to Revise the Statutes Governing Chemical Control of Rodents as
Agricultural Pests.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 1471-N, sub-§ 2, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 65, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Chemical control of rodents by persons engaged in the production of agricultural commodities and the maintenance of ornamental plantings is already governed by other sections of this statute and by federal pesticide law. An additional permit as now required by this section is duplication and serves no useful purpose.
