AN ACT Concerning School Construction Projects.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 3471, sub-§ 2, ¶ C, sub-¶ ¶ (1) and (2) are enacted to read:

- (1) The board shall adopt no regulation which excludes an application from consideration solely because the application contains proposals for more than one construction project.
- (2) The board shall adopt no regulation which awards points, within a rating system for school construction projects, on the basis of consolidation. This restriction shall not be construed as prohibiting the board from considering the extent to which a project anticipates the future need of the system in rating any project.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to encourage the State Board of Education to give full consideration to multi-faceted school construction projects and to exclude consolidation as a criterion for awarding points in rating school construction project applications.
