**AN ACT to Amend the Salary Range for the State Librarian and the Executive Director of the Historic Preservation Commission.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. 2 MRSA § 6, sub-§ 4, last line**, as repealed and replaced by 1977, c. 697, § 1, is amended to read:

Director of Public Lands;

**State Librarian.**

**Sec. 2. 2 MRSA § 6, sub-§ 6**, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 697, § 1, is amended to read:

**6. Range 85.** The salaries of the following state officials and employees shall be within salary range 85:

Director of Veterans Services;

Director of Civil Emergency Preparedness;

Examiner and Chief Accountant of the Public Utilities Commission;

~~State Librarian;~~

Director of the Office of Energy Resources;

**Executive Director, Historic Preservation Commission.**

**Sec. 3. 2 MRSA § 6, sub-§ 8**, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 697, § 1, is amended to read:

**8. Range 81.** The salaries of the following state officials and employees shall be within salary range 81:

~~Executive Director, Historic Preservation Commission;~~

Assistant Adjutant General.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to adjust the salary level of the positions of State Librarian and Executive Director, Maine Historic Preservation Commission, to be commensurate with the level of administrative responsibility and to be compensated at a range more in line with positions of similar scope within the Department of Educational and Cultural Services.
