SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1041,
L.D. 1278, Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to Motor Vehicles Passing
Stopped School Buses."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of subsection
3 of that part designated "§2019-A." and inserting in its
place the following:

'3. Finding; order. If, beyond a reasonable doubt, the court
finds that the vehicle was used in violation of section 2019,
subsection 2, and that the vehicle was identified by the registration
number plate and other identifying features, it shall order the
registration to be suspended according to subsection 1, and
shall notify the Secretary of State who shall implement the order.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the burden of proof to the
reasonable doubt standard and requires that the vehicle
be identified by both the plate number and other features.
