HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 415,
L.D. 1289, Bill, "AN ACT to Conform Land Use Regulation
in the Unorganized Territory to Statewide Standards."

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the
following:

'Sec. 1-A. 12 MRSA §685-A, sub-§1, as last amended by
PL 1977, c. 694, §222, is further amended by adding at the
end the following new paragraph:

No more than 2 recreation protection districts for remote
ponds may be established in any township.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the number
of remote recreation protection districts to 2 in any
township.
