AN ACT to Provide Seed Money to Expand the Provision of Summer Residential Experiences for Maine Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation; summer residential experiences for Maine children. The following sums are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
