AN ACT Relating to Automobile Graveyard and Junkyard Permit Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 30 MRSA § 2455, sub-§ 1, as amended by PL 1971, c. 260, is further amended to read:

1. More than 100 feet from highway. ~~Fifty dollars~~ **The fee as prescribed by the municipal officers, but not to exceed \$50** for each permit for an automobile graveyard or junkyard located more than 100 feet from any highway, plus the cost of posting and publishing said notice; **or**

Sec. 2. 30 MRSA § 2455, sub-§ 2, as amended by PL 1973, c. 424, § 2, is further amended to read:

2. Within 100 feet from highway. ~~Two hundred dollars~~ **The fee as prescribed by the municipal officers, but not to exceed \$200** for each permit for an automobile graveyard or junkyard located within 100 feet from any highway, plus the cost of posting and publishing said notice.

STATEMENT OF FACT

At present the fee for an automobile graveyard or junkyard is set by statute. This bill would give the municipal officers the opportunity to charge a lower fee if in their opinion a lower fee is in order.
