## AN ACT to Appropriate Funds for the Nursing Home Ombudsman Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The Maine Committee on Aging is seeking an appropriation of \$25,000 to fund an additional staff person, travel expenses and overall expansion of all aspects of the Nursing Home Ombudsman Program on a statewide basis to help the program provide stronger and more effective leadership in advocating for and defending the rights guaranteed to Maine's long-term care residents.
