COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 433, L.D. 1335, Bill,
"AN ACT to Increase Merchandising in State Liquor Stores."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the statement of
fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

The Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages indicates that the loss
of revenue from reduced prices would be offset by increased
sales. Not only would the "bargain" prices attract sales,
it would make it possible for Maine customers to take advantage
of same locally rather than go to another state for such
bargains.

They have no estimate of the monetary fiscal impact.'

The purpose of this amendment is to put a fiscal note
on the original bill.
