SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 434, L.D. 1337, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Use of Credit Cards at the Kittery Liquor Store Only."

Amend the Bill in the title by striking out the word "Only" and inserting in its place the words 'and at Other Designated Liquor Stores'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the last underlined sentence before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'All such sales shall be for cash, except that, at the one authorized special discount store and at such other state stores as the commission may designate, credit may be extended to the holder of a credit card which authorizes the holder to charge goods or services.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit the commission to authorize the use of credit cards at those state liquor stores which the commission designates.
