STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Concerning Licensing Manufactured Housing Dealers, Itinerant Vendors, Lightening Rod Salesmen and Apprentices and Helper Electricians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 10 MRSA § 9021, sub-§ 4, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 550, § 1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- 4. License term. Licenses shall expire February 28th or at such other times as the Commissioner of Business Regulation may designate and shall be issued on a biennial basis upon payment of a license fee.
 - Sec. 2. 10 MRSA § 9021, sub-§ 5 is enacted to read:
- 5. Renewals. The board shall notify each licensee of the expiration date of his license and indicate the amount of fee required for biennial renewal. Notice shall be mailed to each person's last known address at least 30 days in advance of the expiration date of the license. If any licensee fails to renew within 30 days after expiration, he shall be required to make a new application.
- Sec. 3. 32 MRSA § 1101, sub-§ 1, last sentence, as amended by PL 1975, c. 767, § 31, is further amended to read:

The biennial renewal fee for an apprentice electrician license shall be \$2 \$5.

Sec. 4. 32 MRSA § 1101, sub-§ 3, last sentence, as amended by PL 1975, c. 767, § 32, is further amended to read:

The biennial renewal fee for a helper electrician license shall be \$2 \$5.

Sec. 5. 32 MRSA § 1707, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 56, is amended to read:

§ 1707. Lightening rod manufacturer's and salesman's licenses

The **biennial** fee for issuing or renewing a license to a lightening rod manufacturer shall be \$20 \$40. The **biennial** fee for insuing or renewing a license to a lightening rod salesman shall be \$2 \$5.

Sec. 6. 32 MRSA § 4684-A, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 440, § 2, is amended to read:

§ 4684-A. Renewal application

A renewal application made upon a form prescribed by the Department of Business Regulation shall be filed each year biennially by the applicant upon the anniversary date of the original application on October 31st or at such other times as the Commissioner of Business Regulation may designate. The renewal application shall include all changes or additions in the information required by section 4684. Notice shall be mailed to each person's last known address 30 days in advance of his expiration date. The renewal application shall be accompanied by a \$5 filing \$10 biennial fee.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill is for the purpose of bringing these licensing functions of Manufacturered Housing Board and Itinerant Vendors into uniformity with all others in the department with regard to biennial renewal. The present fee for lightening rod salesmen and apprentice and helper electricians is increased to defray costs.
