HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 456, L.D. 1369, Bill, "AN ACT
Concerning Contracts of Town Managers."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of subsection 1 and
inserting in its place the following:

'1. Contract; term. The town manager shall hold office
for a definite term as specified by a contract with the
municipality. The municipal officers shall execute the contract.
The municipal officers may reappoint the town manager to another
term at the expiration of the contract.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that a town manager shall hold
office for a definite term which shall be specified in a contract
with the municipality and provides that the municipal officers may
reappoint the town manager at the expiration of the contract.
