SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1097,
L.D. 1376, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Home Rule Authority."

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 7th paragraph
the following:


'Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out
everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place
the following:

'§476. Applicability of provisions to certain towns or cities

Sections 471 and 472 shall not apply to cities or towns
whose charters specify the methods of election selection and
term of office of a superintending school committee or board of
education; nor to towns, cities and incorporated districts
authorized by private and special laws to choose school committees
other than those herein provided for.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the exemption
provision of Title 20, section 471 to towns as well as cities
since many towns also have charters.
