SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1133,  
L.D. 1401, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Warning Signs Posted at  
Certain Railroad Grade Crossings under the Public Utilities  
Commission."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the last 4  
lines before the statement of fact and inserting in their  
place the following:

'Nothing in this section shall prevent the Department of Trans-  
portation from making such further regulations for safety at any  
such crossing ~~established under its direction, including~~<sup>a</sup> private,  
temporary, farm or industrial crossing, as it may deem expedient  
or necessary.'
