COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1134, L.D. 1402, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Telephone Company Directories."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of that part designated  
"§2601." and inserting in its place the following:

'§2601. Telephone directories

Every telephone company operating in this State, if ordered  
by the Public Utilities Commission, shall provide the customers  
within a directory area with an errata list of all people in  
the directory area whose names have been omitted through  
telephone company error from the white pages of the telephone  
directory. The errata list shall include the name, street number  
and telephone number of each person who is eligible under this  
section. The errata list shall be compiled within the first 2  
months subsequent to the delivery of the telephone directory.  
This compiled list shall be included in the bills sent to telephone  
customers in the area served by that directory for a period of  
2 months. Nothing in this chapter shall prohibit a telephone  
company from omitting a listing at the request of a customer.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires any telephone company operating in  
Maine that omits a customer's name by company error, to compile  
an errata list of the people that should have been included in

the directory, upon an order from the Public Utilities Commission. The list will contain the names, street address and telephone number of people in a particular directory area and will be sent to all customers in that directory area for a 2-month period. The errata list will be included in the telephone bills sent to customers. The telephone company will have 2 months to compile the list following the delivery of telephone directories to customers.
