COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1144, L.D. 1406, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Detentions, Public Proceedings and
Recording Requirements under the Juvenile Code."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of paragraph A
of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:
'A. When the court finds that the allegations of the
petition are supported by evidence beyond a reasonable
doubt, the court may adjudge that the juvenile committed
a juvenile crime and shall, in all such adjudications, issue
an order of adjudication ~~setting-forth--the-basis-for-its~~
~~findings.~~'

Statement of Fact

This amendment ~~takes~~ out the word "setting" which
was inadvertently not taken out of the original bill.
